Time to remember how quantifiers works

Quantifiers are very important words because they let us express the quantity of something.



A quantifier is a word that usually goes before a noun to express the quantity of the object; for example, we have some milk.

Nouns can be countable or uncountable. Countable nouns can be counted, e.g. *an apple*, *two apples*, *three apples*, etc. Uncountable nouns cannot be counted, e.g. *air*, *rice*, *water*, etc. You are going to see some of them.

Los quantifiers son palabras importantes que nos permiten expresar la cantidad de algo. Un quantifiers usualmente va antes de un sustantivo para expresarla cantidad de objeto, como por ejemplo: tenemos algo de leche.

Los sustantivos pueden ser contables o incontables, se llaman sustantivos contables porque se pueden contar ej: una manzana, dos manzanas, tres manzanas, etc. se llaman sustantivos incontables porque no se pueden contar ej: aire, agua, arroz, etc.
